

ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 1990

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COALDALE BOROUGH CODE,  
CHAPTER 58, FIRE PREVENTION,  
SECTIONS 1,2, AND 4, TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

1. SECTION 58-1 ADOPTION OF FIRE PREVENTION CODE.

There is hereby adopted by the Borough of Coaldale for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire and explosion, that certain Code known as the Fire Prevention Code, NFPA 1, as prepared by the Technical Committee on Fire Prevention, enacted on by the National Fire Prevention Association, Inc., at its annual meeting held May 18 to 21st 1987, being the 1987 edition as approved by the American National Standards Institute, being particularly the 1987 Edition thereof and all latter revisions, and the same is hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein, and from the date on which this chapter shall take effect, the provisions thereof shall be controlling within the limits of the Borough of Coaldale.

2. SECTION 58-2 ENFORCEMENT

The Code hereby adopted shall be enforced by the Borough Code Enforcement Officer, and in lieu thereof, by those empowered under Section 1- 3.2 of the N.F.P.A. Fire Prevention Code when requested to do so by the Code Enforcement Officer or Borough Council.


3. SECTION 58-4 LIMITS FOR STORAGE OF FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS AND GASES

Repealed.


4. SECTION 58-7 This Ordinance, and the Amendments herein, shall become effective immediately, and to the extent the Amendments are inconsistent with the prior provisions of Chapter 58 of the Coaldale Borough Code, said inconsistent provisions are hereby repealed and superseded.
