

ORDINANCE NO. 4 OF 1993

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE GRANTING OF HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES AT THE REQUEST OF ANY HANDICAPPED PERSON WHO IS A RESIDENT OF THE BOROUGH OF COALDALE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Coaldale, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. At the request of any handicapped person, the Borough Council, by motion, may authorize the erection on a borough street, as close as possible to their place of residence, a numbered sign or signs indicating that that place is reserved for that handicapped person, and that no parking is allowed there by other than that handicapped person. At the discretion of the Borough Council, it may, by motion, remove any signs erected pursuant to this section at any time.

Section 2. The Borough may, at its discretion, set up guidelines, which at its discretion, may be changed, or deviated from at anytime to regulate the granting of parking spaces for handicapped persons as set forth in Section 1. Further, the Borough may appoint a commission composed of three (3) people to review all requests or applications and make any recommendation to the Borough Council.

Section 3. Any unauthorized person parking in spaces established pursuant to Section 1, shall be guilty of a summary offense and pay a fine of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars.


Section 4. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and the same is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage, and approved in the manner prescribed by law.
