

ORDINANCE NO. 99-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF COALDALE AMENDING ORDINANCE 98-8 KNOWN AS THE ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCE OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF COALDALE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Coaldale, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of same that Ordinance 98-8, the Animal Control Ordinance be amended as follows:

**Section 40**    **PROSECUTION:**

(a) The Animal Control Officer shall provide to any person determined to be in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance and instructing that individual that if he or she will report to the office of the Chief of Police and pay, the designated sum set by the Borough of Coaldale, enclosed within the envelope provided to the Borough within the time limit, the act will save the violator from prosecution of payment of the fines prescribed in section 37, 38, and 39 of this Ordinance.

(b) In case of any unlawful acts, the Animal Control Officer or any sworn Police Officer shall institute an appropriate action or proceeding at law to exact the penalty provided in Sections 37, 38, and 39 of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage, and approved in the manner prescribed by law.
