

ORDINANCE NO. 2000- 4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENACTED ON SEPTEMBER 18, 1964 AND SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS THERETO IMPOSING SEWER RENTALS OR CHARGES FOR USE OF THE SEWAGE COLLECTION SYSTEM OWNED AND OPERATED BY THIS BOROUGH AND OTHERS AND FOR SERVICES RENDERED IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

The COUNCIL of the BOROUGH OF COALDALE, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, ENACTS and ORDAINS as follows:

Section 3 governing computation of sewer rentals for charges.

Paragraph A subparagraph 3 and paragraph B enacted on September 18, 1964 and amendments thereto are hereby AMENDED as follows:

“In either of the foregoing cases, such sewer rentals or charges shall be computed in accordance with the following metered rate schedule; subject, however, to the minimum sewer rentals or charges provided herein:

<u>METERED RATE SCHEDULE</u>	
<u>Quantity</u>	<u>Per Quarter</u>
Each 1,000 gallons	\$2.10

Notwithstanding the foregoing metered rate schedule, the minimum sewer rental or charge shall be TWENTY-ONE (\$21.00) DOLLARS per quarterly billing period.

B. Flat Rate Rentals or Charges:

Sewer rentals or charges for Sanitary Sewage and Industrial Wastes discharged into the Sewage Collection System from any improved property when the volume of water usage shall not be metered and when the actual volume of discharge shall not be metered as permitted in this ordinance shall be computed at the rate of \$21.00 per quarterly billing period, the same constituting the minimum sewer rental or charge.”

This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption and shall be reflected upon the next billing cycle of the Coaldale-Lansford-Summit Hill Sewer Authority.




