

ORDINANCE NO. 2000- 6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF COALDALE AMENDING ORDINANCE 98-8, KNOWN AS THE ANIMAL CONTROL ORDINANCE OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF COALDALE, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 2 DEFINITIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Borough of Coaldale, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of same that Ordinance 98-8 Article 1, Section2, Subsection C(5), of the Animal Control Ordinance be amended to read as follows:

Section 2 **DEFINITIONS:**

(C.) "Animal nuisance" is created when an animal:

5. Barks, whines, howls, honks, brays, cries or makes any other noises, continuously and/or incessantly for a period of ten (10) minutes or make such noise intermittently for one-half (1/2) hour or more to the disturbance of any person any time of the day or night regardless of whether the animal or bird is physically situated in or upon private property, said noise being a nuisance, provided that at the time the animal or bird is making such noise no person is trespassing or threatening to trespass upon private property in or upon which the animal or bird is situated nor is there nay other legitimate cause which justifiably provoked the animal or bird.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage, and approved in the manner prescribed by law.
