

AMENDMENT TO THE BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES
ORDINANCE NO. 08 OF 2007

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF COALDALE,
SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA CHANGING AND AMENDING THE VEHICLES
AND TRAFFIC ORDINANCE NO. 1-1997 AND ARTICLE IV SNOW AND EMERGENCIES
SECTION 100-23 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF COALDALE

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough
of Coaldale that the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Coaldale, Section 4, Snow and Ice
Emergencies is hereby amended to include the following:

Section 4A Authority for Borough to Remove Snow and Ice and Collect Cost, Plus 10% from
Owner, Occupant or Tenant of Abutting Property. In any case where the owner, occupant or tenant, as
aforesaid, shall fail, neglect or refuse to comply with any provision of the second section of this part,
within the time limit prescribed therein, the Borough authorities may proceed immediately to clear all
snow and/or ice from the sidewalk of such delinquent, and ot collect the expenses thereof, with an
additional amount of ten per centum (10%) thereof, from such owner, occupant or tenant, as the case
may be, which may be in addition to any fine or penalty imposed under section four of this part.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDAINED that Article IV Section 100-23 is hereby
amended to read as follows:

**Article IV
Snow and Ice Emergencies**

§ 100-23. Parking prohibited on certain streets.

B. The highways or portions thereof to which the provisions of this Article shall be applicable
during all periods of emergency declared as provided in §100-22 shall be as described below:

Highway

Phillips Street
Bull Run Street

Limits

Bull Run Street to Coaldale Lansford Borough Line
Water Street (Route 209) to Phillips Street

C. Removing and impounding vehicles. In addition to any and other penalties provided herein,
the Borough shall have the authority to remove and impound any vehicle which is parked in violation of
either Section B of this part or Section 100-21(c) which provides for vehicles facing in a northerly
direction from November 1st to April 1st.
