RE-ORGINIZATIONAL MEETING MINUTES
221/223 Third St., Coaldale, PA 18218
January 4, 2022 6:00pm

Mayor Whildin swore in council members Angela Krapf, Jacob Adamitis and Francis Hutta.

Mayor Whildin called the meeting to order followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Mayor Herb Whildin, Councilwoman Angela Krapf, Councilman Wayne Figner, Councilwoman Claire Remington, Councilwoman Yvonne Stoffey, Councilman Ken Hankey Jr., Councilman Francis Hutta, and Councilwoman Jacob Adamitis were present. Council President Angela Krapf takes over the meeting.

Angela Krapf asks for nominations for President Pro Tem. Claire Remington nominates Yvonne Stoffey, seconded by Jake Adamitis and upon voice vote it was **unanimous** for Yvonne Stoffey, which she accepted.

2022 meeting dates and times were discussed. Angela suggested to keep the regular monthly meetings the same, the 2nd Tuesday of the month at 7pm with executive session at 6:30 prior to the meeting. The November meeting falls on Election Day and will be moved to November 1st. Budget meetings will be held at 5:30pm prior to the regular meetings in September, October, November, and December.


